

3.1 Tryout Invitation an Confirmation

- 1. One week before the tryout, team manager will email "Tryout Invitation" to players with tryout date/time/location.
- 2. Upon receiving "Tryout Invitation", players must reply to confirm (accept or decline) the invitation before deadline.
- 3. Fail to reply before the deadline, will be treated as "Decline the tryout invitation."
- 4. Make-up tryouts: Players must email team manager to request makeup tryout before the confirmation deadline. It is at the Coach's discretion to grant the request. If granted, coach will arrange makeup tryout at later date. Note: It is not guarantee that there is any position available after scheduled tryout date.

3.2 Tryout Day

- 1. Tryout duration is two hours for each grade.
- 2. Players have to
 - a. Bring towel, water, and a basketball (marked with player's name).
 - b. Wear basketball shoes, and shorts (no jean/jewelry/watch/ear ring, & etc.).
 - c. New applicants wear White t- shirt (NO picture/large letter on the shirt).
 - d. FYBC players wear FYBC Blue jersey.
- 3. Arrive 20 minutes earlier to check-in; sign waiver (new applicants). And, wait for instruction to enter the gym.
- If player is late for 5 minutes after tryout starting time, s/he will be eliminated from the tryout.
- 5. Players, Parents, and Spectators should follow Covid-19 safety protocols and measures set by FYBC.
- 6. Parents and spectators should not interfere the tryout process; no applaud, cheer, nor side-line coaching etc.
- 7. No drop-in tryout during annual tryout.

3.3 After Tryout; Admit/Deny Notice

- 1. Within one week, team coach will collect feedback from the coach panel and email team manager the roster.
- 2. One week after tryout, team manager will email "Admit, or Deny" notice to all tryout participants.
- 3. Admitted players must reply (Accept or Decline) to team manager. Fail to reply will be treated as "Decline".

4 Summer Session & New School Year

- 1. At beginning of Jun, team manager will email summer session information to players on the roster.
- 2. At beginning of Aug, team manager will email the regular session schedule (either monthly or quarterly).
